

#1 Journey of Prayer - Together for Tomorrow Campaign
Topic: Discernment of God's Direction

Meditation: God called Abraham out from his home to "go". Abraham did not know where he was going for God nor what he would be doing for God, he just went in obedience to God. It was the beginning of a faith journey that ended at the edge of the Promised Land. Abraham was obedient and God was faithful. BPC is on a faith journey, called out from the comfort and security of what has been provided by previous generous and sacrificial generations. Now we are asking God to layout the course ahead for us: the challenge of new and expanded ministries, bonding together traditional and contemporary styles of praising and worshipping Him, use and expansion of his facilities in this place, the uniting of His people to shine His light on this hill to glorify Him.

Prayer: Lord, it is my desire to know you and do your will. So often I am overwhelmed by the blurring pace of life that I can't hear you and I can't feel your presence. Help to quiet me Lord, to give me focus in my daily life. Help me to listen for you and hear that special purpose for which you created me. Please Lord, fill me with your Holy Spirit and change my heart and my mind to be tuned in to you. Help me to be part of your plan at Bonhomme Presbyterian Church and help me to say "yes" when you call upon me. Lord, I pray that your purpose for Bonhomme will be clearly known to all within its walls and that it will be the holy place you have called it to be. I pray that we would be one people, your people. Thank you for loving me and all your people here so much.

During the next two weeks, please pray every day, for even just a minute, for discernment in God's direction for BPC and how each of us can be part of God in action in this place. If you don't know exactly what to pray for, take comfort and counsel in reading Romans 8:26-38 "In the same way the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groans that words cannot express. And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints in accordance with God's will."
