Topic: A Walk of Faith Never Ends

Meditation: In John Bunyan's "The Pilgrim's Progress", the faith journey of the central character, Christian, does not end when the heavy burden of his sin falls from his back, landing at the foot of the cross. That he has come to faith is surely life changing but his journey is a continuing one, as he returns home to try and "save" his family to Christ. Paul is spectacularly converted along the road to Emmaus but soon discovers his faith walk has only just begun, for Christ has set before him a long and arduous path to reach the Gentiles. The Apostle John, after enduring years of struggle and physical harm and out living all of the other apostles, as an older man discovers that God still has important work for him on the island of Patmos and his writing of the Book of Revelation. So too, after we have come to the point of faith in Christ have not reached God's finishline. He still seeks to use us in ways we may not now know but in ways that He will reveal to us. We must keep on keeping on.

Prayer: Father, you know where I am in my relationship with Christ. I pray that you will help me deepen that relationship. Help me to stay on the path you have laid before me even if I'm feeling that discovering and developing my own faith is enough for me to be concerned with.
